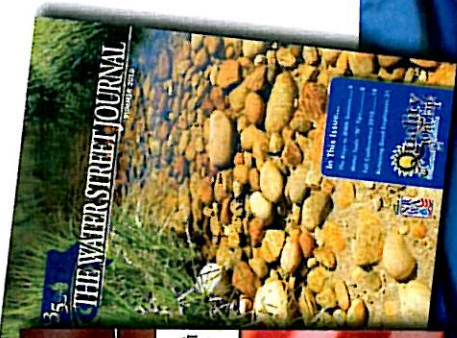
- ◆ **On-site Technical Assistance**
